Groups & Families Discussion Questions

Follow along with the sermon and use these questions to dive a little deeper with your group, with your families at home or for your own personal reflection.

Sermon Notes: Can you identify the main point, the subpoints and application of today's message?

Life Group Questions

1. Read Acts 1:1-12 and 2:1-13. What key themes or repeated words do you find?
2. Why do you think the disciples asked Jesus if He was going to “restore” the kingdom (1:6)? Was this a fair question?
3. Recount the reasons why God is unstoppable. Which one is most weighty for you? How does that reminder help us when dealing with “the funk”?
4. Many believe that Acts 2 is the beginning of the church. Read Acts 11:15, 1 Cor 12:12-14 and Col 1:18 and see if you can defend this position.
5. Read John 7:37-39. Why do you think the church was given the Spirit and what role does the Spirit play in a believer’s life? (cf Acts 1:5, 2:4)
6. Discuss the difference between something that is descriptive and something that is prescriptive. Do you think what is going on in Acts 2 is descriptive only or both?
7. How important do you think the local church is to the health of a believer? What should a healthy church look like?
8. Three key words for The Orchard are love, equip and reach. What are you most excited about and how do you want to be involved?
