Life Group Questions

- 1. Conversation Starter: Let's be honest... how long is an average shower for you?
- 2. We are designed to let the gospel flow through us to other people. What are some hindrances that restrict this flow?
- 3. Paul talks about "the hope of Israel" in 28:20 then proceeds to talk about "the kingdom of God" and Jesus. What does this tell us about the Jewish idea of the kingdom, and how does Jesus fit into the picture? (Cf. Acts 1:3, 6-8; 2 Sam 7; Is 53)
- 4. "The hope of Israel has become the hope of the world." What excites you about God's mission and kingdom?
- 5. Recall some of the opposition the gospel faced in the book of Acts. Compare Acts 1:8 with 28:30-31. That God achieved his purposes despite these influences tells us what about God? How does that give you hope?
- 6. When it comes to the spread of the gospel, what is in your control and what is outside of your control? What does it look like to faithfully, sacrificially, work for the cause of the gospel, and trust God with the rest?
