### ***Life Group Questions***

1. Conversation starter: What do you prefer, cats or dogs, and why is it dogs?
2. Read John 13:1-17. What is the story of the foot-washing all about? Why did Jesus use foot-washing as an illustration?
3. Why do you think it's difficult for people in the church to be honest about how they're going or feeling? How does John 13:14 speak into that?
4. How should we go about dealing with sin in the church? (cf. Gal 6:1; Matt 18:15-17)
5. What are some ways that we can bear one another's burdens in this group? (cf. Gal 6:2)
6. What difference would it make in evangelism if we as a group really cared for each other as well as the church as a whole? (cf. John 13:34-35)
7. Is there a need that this group is aware of that we could meet collectively? (e.g. A neighbours gardening)
