Groups & Families Discussion Questions

Follow along with the sermon and use these questions to dive a little deeper with your group, with your families at home or for your own personal reflection.

Life Group Questions

- 1. What often ends up in your "too hard basket"?
- 2. What obstacles are there to sharing our faith today?
- 3. Read Acts 8:1-8. What would your response have been to that level of persecution? Why do you think the disciples kept on preaching? What can we learn from that?
- 4. 'Trials are God's machine for growth if we have courage." Explain what was meant by this statement. Why is courage needed for growth?
- 5. Read Romans 5:3-4 and James 1:2-4. In what sense are trials "pure joy"? What does it look like to respond well to God in the midst of trial?
- 6. Recall from Acts 8:26-40 and the wider context what are some of the geographical and ethnic boundaries the gospel overcomes. What does that tell us about the gospel?
- 7. Read Matt 28:19-20. How does the Great Commission help us to trust God when we share our faith?
- 8. What do you need to do this week/month to take sharing your faith out of the "too hard basket?"
