Groups & Families Discussion Questions

Life Group Questions

1. What is the strangest country or culture you have visited? Or what do you think people find most strange about NZ culture?
2. In what sphere of life do you have the greatest opportunity to be a witness to non-Christians?
3. How have you seen God's Word, Spirit, or Church operate in your life, helping you resist temptation to sin? Share examples that come to mind.
4. What would it look like in your life group / pod to cultivate a culture of confessing sin and praying for one another? (see James 5:16). Remember, this is not legalistic, but is about helping one another live in freedom.
5. What things does our culture most often criticise us for as Christians? Do you see criticism and / or persecution getting worse in the future? Or do you see the situation improving?
6. What are some ways in which your life group can demonstrate to the world that God's way of life is best? Make a plan to serve together as a life group in the community.
7. What is one thing that you are going to apply in your life this week from 1 Peter 2:11-17?
