### ***Life Group Questions***

1. Conversation starter: Do you have a story where you didn't quite 'walk worthy' of a particular office?
2. What is the best image you can come up with for standing firm?

3. Read Ephesians 6:19-20. What is Paul an ambassador for? Do you have the same conviction?
4. How does the Greek pre-fix 'sun' (with, together) affect the way you understand this passage and by extension this book? How are you going living this out?
5. Do you ever find yourself being frightened away from the truth? Why/why not?
6. Do you find assurance in the fact that you can withstand opposition together? Do you have an example of this happening in your life?
7. What is your expectation of the Christian life? Is suffering a disappointing surprise every time?
8. How are you going with the application? Re-affirming 3 culturally challenged truths, 2 Christian friendships and remembering the memory verse?
