3.	In what ways could we implicitly be causing singles to feel "second rate"?
4.	How does Paul view singleness in 1 Corinthians 7?
5.	What reasons does Paul give that promote singleness as a valid and viable option? Evaluate the strength of his argument.
6.	What are the implications of Paul's argument for us as a church? Is there anything we could be doing different or better?
7.	For singles, what would need to shift in your singleness (attitude, action) in order to do singleness well by single-mindedly pursuing Christ?
8.	For church broadly and us as a life group, how can we be family to singles?
