Groups & Families Discussion Questions

Follow along with the sermon and use these questions to dive a little deeper with your group, with your families at home or for your own personal reflection.

Sermon Notes: Can you identify the main point, the subpoints and application of today's message?

Life Group Questions

1. Conversation Starter: What is the most awe-inspiring building you've been to? What did you feel, and how did it make you feel that way?
2. What are some challenges we face in Western culture when it comes to being "built together" as a spiritual community?
3. In what ways might our church sometimes resemble scattered bricks rather than a cathedral? What's lost when we live disconnected from one another?
4. What does it mean in practical terms that Jesus is our "Cornerstone" for how we relate to him and build our lives?
5. Peter says God builds us up so that we may "declare the praises of him who called us out of darkness into his wonderful light." What are some ways we as a group (not just individuals) can do this in our community?
6. How could you personally take a step this week to move from "scattered brick" to "living stone in God's house"? Consider the questions on Sunday:
 - a. Built together – How can I deeply engage with the church?
 - b. Grounded in Christ – Where in my life do I need to re-engage with "coming to Christ?"
 - c. Set apart to shine – What is my part to play in helping us better reflect God to the world?
