## ***Life Group Questions***

1. Conversation Starter: How long would you last standing in a circle with 99 other people if the last to leave wins \$500,000? (One of MrBeast's many challenges...)
2. What stood out to you most from the parable of the dishonest manager? Why do you think Jesus told such an unusual story?
3. In verse 8, Jesus commends the manager's shrewdness. How would you define "shrewdness" in a godly context? What does it look like to be shrewd with money as a disciple?
4. How does this passage challenge the way our culture typically thinks about wealth, success, and possessions?
5. Verse 9 says to "make friends by means of unrighteous wealth." What do you think Jesus means by that? What are some practical ways we can use our resources with eternity in mind?
6. Jesus says, "One who is faithful in very little is also faithful in much" (v.10). How might faithfulness with money reveal the condition of our hearts?
7. In verse 13, Jesus says, "You cannot serve God and money." What are some signs that money might be taking too big a place in our lives? How can we guard our hearts against that?
8. Looking ahead, what is one way you want to steward your money or possessions differently in light of this passage?
