Life Group Questions

1. Conversation Starter: If you could go back in time and hang with any person in the Bible, who would you choose? (Try not to all say Jesus!)
2. When you think of the Corinthians, what comes to mind? What is some of the background to the letter?
3. Read 1 Cor 1:11; 5:1; 7:1. What is a broad outline of the book, or a quick way to think through its structure? Flick through the headings of your Bible and see if you can fill this out a little more.
4. Why do you think Paul bothered to write 1 Corinthians? Why not just write them off as a lost cause? What hope does that give you and me?
5. Why does the church matter? Why are you a part of one? Why are you here tonight answering these questions? What is at stake and what opportunities lie ahead if we “do church” well?
6. Which of the topics raised in 1 Corinthians are you most looking forward to exploring more?
