2. Read the 10th commandment in Exodus 20:17. What is coveting? Ever struggled with any of the thoughts/emotions described in Ps 73:3-14?
3. Describe Asaph's spiritual journey using the three "surely" statements as indicating points along the way (v1; v13; v18).
4. Read v21-22. How do our emotions so often influence what we otherwise know with our head is true?
5. What's one way that you can better utilize God's God's precepts (Bible), people (Christian community) and place (church events) to help you stay the course?
6. How does an eternal perspective make a difference to your view of the prosperity of the godless (v18-20, 27), the pain of the godly (v23-26, 28) and maintaining a life of purity (v13-14)?
