Groups & Families Discussion Questions

Follow along with the sermon and use these questions to dive a little deeper with your group, with your families at home or for your own personal reflection.

Sermon Notes: Can you identify the main point, the subpoints and application of today's message?

Life Group Questions

1. Conversation starter: What is the coolest explosion you've seen?
2. Read Psalm 34. What does the context of this Psalm add to the understanding of Peters exposition of it in 1 Peter 3:8-9?
3. Would you say that as a group you all are 'like-minded' for the same things in life? Spiritually? How is this seen in the way you act with and towards each other?
4. How's your temper? Is the way you react to people the same as Christ would? Have you reacted better to situations/people this week and not "blown up"?
5. Share with the group who it is you are loving sympathetically, compassionately, humbly this week and how it's going.
6. Are you motivated by the gospel to live different to the world? How often do you think about the gospel during the week?
7. Read vv9 and 12. Then compare to v7. Does the blessing of God being attentive to your prayers motivate you? Why or why not?
8. As you reflect on your Christian life (however long) is there a progression of positive change to be more like Jesus? Can you identify what is causing this or perhaps what is stopping this growth?
