1. Icebreaker: If, out of the blue, you could win any prize, what would you choose? And why?
2. Read Ephesians 2:1-10. What verses would you take a friend to if your friend said, "God just seems so harsh"? How would you talk them through this common misconception?
3. How would you define 'grace'? How can anyone receive God's grace?
4. Does 'faith' differ from mere 'belief'? If so, how?
5. "We are not saved by good works but for good works." Agree or disagree? Isn't this legalism? Why or why not?
6. Paul says you are "God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works" (v10). So how, in the weeks ahead and very specifically, do you plan to apply this and express your divine purpose with, say, two new actions -- one inside and one outside the church?
