Life Group Questions

1. Conversation Starter: What was mealtimes like for you growing up? Any weird/unique rules enforced?
2. 1 Cor 11:33 & 40 speak of God as a God of order. Where else do we see the truth of this? Do we reflect that order to the world in the way we operate as a church? How so?
3. When you take communion what do you concentrate your thinking on as you reflect?
4. Our sin, His death, resurrection, His future return and much more are all symbolised in communion. Is the incredible selflessness of Christ something you reflect on too? If not why not?
5. We may not abuse the Lords table like the Corinthians did with their selfishness but as you look at your life can you see where you are selfish? How can you change that to be more selfless like Christ?
6. Is your natural instinct to considers others first before yourself? How do we change our default to be others first?
7. As a group how can we help and encourage and keep each other accountable to the pursuit of selflessness in reflection of and response to Christ?
