### ***Life Group Questions***

1. Conversation starter: Tell of a time your were inappropriately dressed (either overdressed or underdressed) for an occasion.
2. At a birdseye view, what is the purpose, structure and message of 1 Corinthians 11-14?
3. Consider the cultural elements in play at Corinth. What can you recall, and how do they aid your understanding of 1 Corinthians 11:2-16?
4. Discuss the principle of 11:3. What is headship and how is it related to the Trinity and the creation order?
5. What are some dangers/abuses of this principle that we need to fight against? i.e. What doesn't it mean?
6. What are "head coverings" (figuratively speaking) in the church today?
7. What principles can you take away from this passage today and what do they look like in practice in your life?
