Groups & Families Discussion Questions

Follow along with the sermon and use these questions to dive a little deeper with your group, with your families at home or for your own personal reflection.

Life Group Questions

1. Icebreaker: If you could eat lots of one thing (guilt-free and calorie-free), what would it be?
2. Read 1 Peter 1:22-2:3 in the NIV (and then the NLT if possible). In a short sentence, try and state the Big Idea of the passage.
3. Why are we to have a sincere, deep, and heart love for each other (1:22)? And how do you think that differs from worldly affection?
4. In 1:23-25, list the comparisons and the contrasts. What two things are eternal? How are they connected?
5. What might “being born again of imperishable seed” have to do with the command (“therefore”) in 2:1?
6. Explain and discuss the 'three tenses of salvation'. How is understanding this helpful in your journey as a Christian?
7. What's one way (perhaps of those suggested) that you will use to try and grow your hunger for God's Word in the coming weeks?
