Groups & Families Discussion Questions

Follow along with the sermon and use these questions to dive a little deeper with your group, with your families at home or for your own personal reflection.

Life Group Questions

1. Read John 1:29-30; 34; 35-42. Who is mentioned as John the Baptist's disciple? In what ways did he respond to what John said?
2. What has been the impact of this little-known disciple's faithfulness and initiative, and how does that challenge and encourage you?
3. Read Mark 1:29-31. What does this incident indicate about Jesus? What do you think was the long-term impact on Peter's family?
4. Read Matthew 16:21-23. What's interesting about both Peter's and Jesus' statements?
5. Read Matthew 26:31-35; 69-75. How well does Jesus know Peter and the future (and what's the significance of that for you)? How well does Peter know himself (and what might be the significance of that for you)?
6. Read John 21:15-19. What is Jesus asking Peter to do and what do you think that means? Do you think there's any significance to the request being stated 3x?
7. Read Acts 2:14; 36-41. To what do you attribute Peter's transformation? How does Peter's life (and death) encourage and challenge you?
