Groups & Families Discussion Questions

Life Group Questions

1. Conversation starter: Have you ignored or over-followed instructions with funny or detrimental consequences? Please share.
2. As you look over the series in 1 Corinthians 11-14 can you understand the big picture points Paul is making? Can you also highlight the specific problems in the church at Corinth that Paul uses to make these points?
3. Discuss if interpreted tongues in church is as beneficial as prophecy? Why or why not?
4. Do you agree that we need to keep our minds engaged or would you argue that there is benefit to others when we disengage? How can we increase our desire and ability to stay intellectually involved?
5. What are some creative ways you've seen a church service done in other cultures? Was it still done with order? Can you see how we misrepresent our God when we are disorderly?
6. Do you go to church with the attitude of edifying others or yourself? How can we change this perspective if not or better act on our belief if we do?
