2. Read Colossians 2:9. If you were one of Christ's disciples when he was on earth do you think you would have struggled to believe Jesus was God? Why or why not?
3. How many instances can you recall where Jesus claimed to be God in one way or another?
4. Is there any aspect to Jesus' humanity that you struggle to comprehend and why?
5. Read Galatians 4:4-5. Can you explain why Jesus had to be both God and man in order to forgive us of our sins?
6. When it comes to the application: repent, rejoice, retell. Which of these do you find easy and which do you find hard? Why? How can you remedy this?
7. Regardless of your perspective on Christmas, will you commit to leveraging this festive season by sharing the story of Christ's incarnation? How? With who?
8. Pray for individuals, opportunity, and boldness in sharing this good news. Keep each other accountable to living this out.
