4. Why do you think it is that we struggle to extend the same level of extravagant hospitality that we see shown by Abraham and Rebecca?
5. How can we bring about a change in this attitude? Will a better understanding of Gods hospitality to us, and therefore everyone else, help?
6. When you look back on your life, have you grown and are you continuing to grow in your love for one another?
