4. What are some implications/applications for you, personally, given the Gospel accounts' trustworthiness?
5. How would you utilize the legal standard of proof ("evidence beyond a reasonable doubt") in responding to someone who says, "I won't believe Christianity unless you can prove it to me 100%"?
6. Read 1 Peter 3:15. Discuss a time when and why you've done this badly, or well.
7. What's one thing you can do to be better prepared "to give an account for the hope that you have"?
