Groups & Families Discussion Questions

Follow along with the sermon and use these questions to dive a little deeper with your group, with your families at home or for your own personal reflection.

Life Group Questions

1. Conversation Starter: Are you a good directions-giver? Let's put it to the test. Choose one of your hobbies and explain to the group how to do it; or, choose a location and give the group directions to get there.
2. Read John 14:1-11. What is the context of the teaching? Imagine yourself in the room – what would the atmosphere be like and how might Jesus' words be received?
3. How might you engage with someone who told you that they believed that there are many ways to God? What lines of reasoning defend John 14:6?
4. How can you make a case beyond reasonable doubt that Jesus is trustworthy? If He is – what difference does it make?
5. Do you think it's unfair that there is only one way to God? How might you deal with the logical and the emotional aspects of this question? (cf. 1 Pet 3:18)
6. What is an appropriate response to God making a way to Him/heaven available? What practical steps can you take to do that this week?
