Groups & Families Discussion Questions

Follow along with the sermon and use these questions to dive a little deeper with your group, with your families at home or for your own personal reflection.

Life Group Questions

1. Conversation starter: Have you ever been lost? Describe what happened and how you felt.

2. Read Luke 19:1-10. Describe Zaccheus.

3. What strikes you about Jesus and Zaccheus' interaction, especially given the perspective of the people towards him?

4. Read Daniel 7:13-14. What characteristics of deity (or very like deity) do you notice in Daniel's description of the Son of Man?

5. Given that the Son of Man has been given authority to judge (Jn 5:27), and authority to forgive sins (Mk 2:10), what does it mean to you personally that "the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost" at the cost of his own life (see Mark 10:32-34)?

6. How does being reminded of Jesus' mission to seek and to save the lost challenge you to be graciously bolder with friends and family as we approach Christmas get-togethers?
