

538 BC - Return to Israel (decree of Cyrus)


332 BC - Alexander the Great conquers Palestine

5 Responses to the good news of Hellenism

- Sadducees = Corrupt mafia-like priesthood
- Herodians = AKA Hellenistic Jews
- Essenes = Monks of Judaism
- Zealots = Violent Jewish militia
- Pharisees = Pious ones, devoted to obedience

2 Responses to the Good News of Jesus

• Pharisees - Mere piety over moral purity w1-8

(Insider)

- Ritualism over righteousness vv9-16
- Hard work over heart work vv17-23

• Foreigner - Bold and believing w24-26

(Outsider)

- Confident and conformed w27-28
- Faithful and free vv29-30

• Pharisees - Mere piety over moral purity w1-8

(Insider)

- Ritualism over righteousness vv9-16
- Hard work over heart work vv17-23

• Foreigner - "Human wholeness comes,

Outsider not by denying reality,

but conforming to it."
