5. Are you living out the world's wisdom in the church or Gods wisdom? Does the wisdom of God make sense to you and are you living that out in the church?
6. How did you respond for your application this week? In what way are going to serve the local church better as you take it more seriously as you know God does?
7. What can we be praying for each other in this area and how can we help keep each other accountable to taking the church seriously in the weeks ahead?
