1. Conversation Starter: What's the most humorous insult you've given or heard?

3. What does it mean that trials "prove the genuineness" of our faith? How is faith like gold being refined by fire?
4. According to verse 7, what is the ultimate outcome of a faith that endures testing?
5. How can someone "love" Jesus and "believe" in Him even though they haven't seen Him?
6. Peter says believers are "filled with an inexpressible and glorious joy." Have you ever experienced that kind of joy in your faith? What prompted it?
7. What does verse 9 mean by "the outcome of your faith, the salvation of your souls"? How does that give you hope during trials?
8. How might these verses encourage someone who is currently going through suffering or doubt?
