### ***Life Group Questions***

1. What topic could you give a 20 minute presentation on completely unprepared?
2. What ways are our marriages and families under attack in New Zealand today?
3. How do the world, the flesh and the devil work against marriages and families? (What is the “world” and “flesh”?)
4. How does the curse in Genesis 3 interfere with husbands and wives playing their God-given roles in marriage? What difference does faith in Jesus make?
5. What is the context for the “household code” in Ephesians 5:15-6:9 and what difference do you think that makes in your marriage and family? (See Eph 6:10-18)
6. Read Eph 5:18. What does it mean to “be filled with the Holy Spirit?” How does that help us?
7. The family stands against the devil by submitting to one another through living out their role. What does this look like practically? What should husbands, wives, children be doing?
8. What tools or tips have you received for you marriage or family that you wish you had received earlier (and would pass on to others!)?
9. What could a family altar look like for you? How do you/can you encourage faith In your spouse and family?
