Life Group Questions

1. Conversation Starter: What renovation or project would you love to do if you had the time and money?
2. According to Ephesians 1:8–10, what does Paul say God has done for us and revealed to us?
3. Paul says God's grace was given "with all wisdom and understanding." What does that mean for us as we contemplate the chaos in the world and ours?
4. According to verse 10, what is God's ultimate purpose for history? What does it mean that everything will be united under Christ?
5. How does knowing the "end of the story" change the way you handle the difficult or "mysterious" chapters of your life right now?
6. The word for "plan" or "administration" refers to the management of a household. If we view God as the "Lead Project Manager" of the universe, how does that shift your perspective on the things in your life that currently feel "mismanaged" or out of your control?
7. If God's ultimate goal is to bring "things in heaven and things on earth" together in harmony, how can we as a group act as Christ's ambassadors in our community this week? (cf. 2 Cor 5:11-21)
