## ***Life Group Questions***

1. Conversation Starter: What is one thing you try to keep in really good condition?
2. Paul begins Ephesians with a long prayer of praise for who we are “in Christ.” What stands out to you about our spiritual blessings in Christ?
3. What Does It Mean to Be “In Christ”? What does being it mean for your identity and how is that different from how the world defines identity?
4. How does beginning with praise shape the way we think about our Christian life?
5. In Eph 2:1-10 Paul contrasts who we were with what God has done. How does remembering that we were saved by grace—not works—guard us from pride, guilt, or striving in the Christian life?
6. In 4:1 Paul says, “Therefore... walk in a manner worthy of the calling you have received.” Why do you think Paul spends three chapters on doctrine before calling believers to action? What happens when we try to live chapters 4–6 without first understanding chapters 1–3?
7. How does understanding your position in Christ practically empower you to “walk” differently in everyday life (relationships, speech, forgiveness, purity)?
8. Which passage from chapters 1–3 would be most life-shaping for you to memorize right now? How might hiding that truth in your heart help you live out chapters 4–6?
