### ***Life Group Questions***

1. Conversation Starter: How “prepped” are you for an emergency response?
2. Why is it important for the church to be prepared for times of trial? (See v. 5, 9, 23, 33, 34, 35, 37)
3. Read Daniel 9:20-27 & 2 Thess 2. Without getting too bogged down in the details (note: a “week” or a “seven” is considered a seven-year period), what do you learn about the “abomination that causes desolation” and the person behind it (Dan 9:27)? Why does this figure need to be someone in the future?
4. Read Mark 13:5-13. What type trials can disciples of Jesus be expected to face?
5. How do we confidently face these trials head on? (See Mark 13:26-27, 11, 20-21)
6. What does it look like practically to choose to live faithfully for Jesus today?
