Life Group Questions

- 1. Conversation Starter: What phrase or parental comment really irked you as a child?
- 2. Walk through Mark 3:20-32. What observations do you make? Give the verses for the "sandwich structure" and what irony do you see?
- 3. Was Jesus being disrespectful to his mother and family? What other interactions between Jesus and His family or teaching on family can you think of? (For e.g. see Mark 9:8-13; John 19:25-27)
- 4. What is a key distinction between an outsider and an insider with Jesus?
- 5. How might someone wrongly assume they are an insider?
- 6. How do you bring yourself under authority? How does this help your walk with God?
- 7. Disciples are those who have been called by Jesus to be with Him and to be sent by Him. What does that look like practically in your life?
- 8. How would you counsel and comfort someone questioning if they have committed the unforgivable sin?
