## Groups & Families Discussion Questions

**Sermon Notes:** Can you identify the main point, the subpoints and application of today's message?

### ***Life Group Questions***

1. Conversation Starter: Besides the crucifixion/resurrection narratives of the Gospels, if you could witness any event in history (without interfering), what would it be and why?"
2. Read Mark 15:1-39. Why do you think Jesus remained silent before Pilate? How does His response reflect His character and mission? (v.1-5)
3. What does the crowd's choice of Barabbas over Jesus reveal about human nature and priorities? How might this apply to our choices today? (v.6-15)
4. How do the soldiers' actions mock Jesus' identity as King? In what ways do people today reject or mock Christ's authority? (v.16-20)
5. Simon of Cyrene was compelled to carry Jesus' cross. How can we relate this to our call to "carry our cross" as disciples of Jesus? (v.21-24)
6. How do you interpret Jesus' cry, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" What does this moment reveal about the depth of Jesus' suffering and His role in taking on humanity's sin? (v.25-37)
7. The tearing of the temple curtain and the centurion's declaration both signify important truths about Jesus' death. How do these events shape your view of Jesus' mission? (v.38-39)
