Groups & Families Discussion Questions

Sermon Notes: Can you identify the main point, the subpoints and application of today's message?

Life Group Questions

- 1) Conversation starter: What is your earliest memory of what you thought heaven would be like? (e.g Mike thought he would ride a cheetah and slide down the neck of a giraffe)

- 2) How do you pursue youthful beauty? In retrospect is it healthy or unhealthy?

- 3) Do you find yourself wanting more specific details about what we will look like in our resurrected bodies? Why do you think that is and how does Paul highlight that we shouldn't?

- 4) Based on the first half of chapter 15 and verses 45-50 can you understand and explain how it is the work of Christ that secures our resurrection? Does this take the pressure of you trying (personally and experientially)?

- 5) Could Jesus return at any moment? Are you always working fully for Him until then?

- 6) What is stopping you or distracting you from living out verse 58 in light of verse 57?

- 7) How can we help each other to stand firm, not letting anything move us, as we live this life with the exciting hope of the resurrection?
