**Sermon Notes:** Can you identify the main point, the subpoints and application of today's message?

### ***Life Group Questions***

1. Conversation Starter: What's an embarrassing moment you can share?
2. Read 1 Tim 2:5. What is a mediator? What are some forms of mediation in the Bible?
3. Read Rom 8:31-39. Why do you think Paul bombards the reader with questions?
4. What forms of opposition do we face? How is God being for us a comfort to you?
5. Consider that Jesus has entered into the Most Holy Place of God's presence *as a man*. (See Heb 9:24) What does that mean for us?
6. What does it mean that no-one can bring a charge or condemnation against God's children? Does that rule out the need for the police? What is Paul's point and how should we handle sin in a fallen and broken world?
7. How can we be secure in our faith when we don't feel it?
