Life Group Questions

1. How does secular culture approach death in terms of humour, denial and beliefs? What do you fear most about death?
2. Read Revelation 1:9-20 and Daniel 7:9-14. From the descriptions and images, list as many characteristics as you can of Jesus, the '**Son of Man**'.
3. In v 17, Jesus describes himself as '**the First and the Last**'. Read Isaiah 44:6 & 48:12, and Revelation 1:8 & 21:6 for God's self-description. Now read Jesus' use of all 3 titles in Revelation 22:12-13. Putting Jesus' and God's statements side by side, what do you conclude about Jesus' identity?
4. How is Jesus' creation of and sovereignty over time a comfort to you in relation to your life and death, and history generally?
5. Read v 18. What three things does Jesus claim as the '**Living One**'? Talk through the significance of each of these for every person.
6. What are some of the things you are looking forward to in eternity?
7. Who are you praying for and looking for opportunities to share the amazing hope of the gospel for this life and the next?
