- 3. Who is the Lord in Mark and which title encourages you and why?
- 4. In the larger section of these 4 situations 4:35- 5:43 there is a contrast between fear & faith. How does this work in our lives? Can we be less fearful and more faithful? How?
- 5. How do we request the Lord's help. Practically whats it look like and how do we make it work.
- 6. What prayer tips and helps can you share with one another?
- 7. What do you think about this "praying for one another" and asking the "whole church" to pray for us?
- 8. Read Eph 3:20-21 & Phil 4:6-7 and discuss their application to our situations of life.
- 9. Share a time when the Lord has done great things or shown mercy that can encourage others in your group.
