Groups & Families Discussion Questions

Follow along with the sermon and use these questions to dive a little deeper with your group, with your families at home or for your own personal reflection.

Sermon Notes: Can you identify the main point, the subpoints and application of today's message?

Life Group Questions

1. Conversation starter: If you had to compete in the Olympics (Summer or Winter), which event would you choose?
2. Recap the message from Sunday. What is 1 Peter all about? Can you remember any themes, purpose, structure?
3. Peter calls believers “elect exiles” (v.1). What do those two words mean, and how might they shape our identity today?
4. What are your expectations of following Jesus? Are you willing to be “weird?”
5. Verse 2 mentions the work of the Father, Spirit, and Son. How does this shape your understanding of salvation?
6. Peter praises God for giving us a “living hope” (v.3). What makes this hope “living,” and how is it different from the hopes people commonly live for?
7. What stands out to you about the inheritance described in verse 4? How might that shape our priorities?
8. Verse 5 says we are being “guarded by God’s power.” What does that mean practically? What does it not mean?
9. How might remembering your identity and inheritance help you when you face rejection, hardship, or suffering?
10. How do we practically anchor our identity and future in Him—even as exiles in this world?
