## ***Life Group Questions***

1. Conversation starter: Who is your favourite immortal movie character and why?
2. Read Lev 19:18 & 34, Prov 25:21-22. How did the Priest and Levite act in relation to these instructions?
3. Read 1 Joh 3:17 and Jam 1:22-27. What are some connections between these 2 passages?
4. To answer the lawyer's question about who his neighbor is, Franz Leenhardt said, "One cannot define one's neighbor; one can only be a neighbor." Is this the attitude you have towards others? Do you expect compassion and care from others or seek to give it without repayment?
5. In your day to day what is it most important that you get done? How do people and the way you treat them fit into that? Are you willing to be inconvenienced by others, even at a cost?
6. Read 1 Joh 4:7-9. When you reflect on the way you treat others, particularly those that are hard to love, are you living up to this principle?
7. Will you, this week (and the rest of your life), be willing to show compassion, care, and commitment to anyone and everyone even at personal cost in order to represent Christ to them?
8. What would be some examples of this show of love from your life in the past and what might it look like this coming week? Will you hold each other accountable to doing this?
